I'm here to guide you through everything you'll need to know for your upcoming visit to watch Rovers!

PRIOR TO THE GAME

Secure your Tickets:

Firstly, you'll need to secure tickets for the fixture you intend to come to; you can browse and purchase tickets to our upcoming fixtures HERE. We recommend tickets within the MKJ Group Family Stand, or if you desire a terrace experience, we recommend the Cooling FX Terrace.


Read our Home Fan Guide:

Before your visit to The Mem for the first time, ensure that you read our Home Fan Guide HERE (link to be provided later) after you have finished this guide. This will provide you with a more comprehensive overview of your day, covering everything from directions to and around the stadium, travel and ticketing.



12:30pm - Park up on Gloucester Road:

As The Mem has extremely limited parking, we would recommend parking up off Gloucester Road, as there are many residential streets with free parking. From Gloucester Road, you can then expect a 7–12 minute walk based upon how far down you park:



If Gloucester Road is busy, you can also try Muller Road or Kellaway Avenue, both of which are a 12–15 minute walk to the stadium.

1pm - Visit the Club Shop:

When you then get to the stadium, visiting the club shop will provide a great start to your day! Each matchday we run a kids' competition, which you will be able to ask about in the shop. Also, you can pick up one of our Kids' Activity Packs, and a colouring page for free. Don't forget to then purchase some Rovers merchandise to get you into the spirit of the day!



1:20pm - Head to the FanZone:

Then, make your way to the FanZone. Although this is not a designated family area, it has a great atmosphere and lots of entertainment for all the family. You will be able to catch some live music, grab a drink and food, or check out the family-friendly Thatchers Bar.

2pm - Head to the Family Area:

After this, if you have purchased MKJ Family Stand or Cooling FX Terrace tickets, head to turnstiles 1-8 at the end of the FanZone. From here, you will be able to enter the stadium and head down to the family area. As well as more food and drinks, there will be various activities, such as face painting and an inflatable goal. You can also meet Captain Gas!

2:50pm - Take your Seats:

Both the MKJ Family Stand and Cooling FX Terrace are very close to the family area, and easily accessible, so you shouldn't have many issues in finding your place! However, if you do become slightly lost, either refer to the map on our matchday guide or ask a steward and they will point you in the right direction.

3pm - KICK-OFF:

Enjoy the game! Up the Gas!



3:45pm - Half-Time:

Help yourselves to a snack or half-time refreshments from the family area or FanZone to get you ready for the second-half!

4pm – Second-Half Kick-Off:#UTG

4:45pm - End of the Match:

After you hopefully watch the Gas get a big win, it'll be time to leave the stadium. Usually, crowds clear quickly, but perhaps wait 5-10 minutes if you don't want to get caught up in a crowd. Travel safely back home!



Our club song is 'Goodnight Irene' which we have used since 1950! The song stuck after we beat Plymouth Argyle comfortably and sang "Goodnight Argyle" to the same tune as their supporters left.

The clubs nickname, The Gas, comes from the fact that we played next to a Gasworks at one of our previous grounds - Eastville.

Our top ever goal scorer is Geoff Bradford, who scored 242 goals in 462 games for the Gas between the years of 1949-1964

The last time we played Bristol city was in 2013, and the last time we played them in the league was 2001.

The most appearances made by one Rovers player is 546, by Stuart Taylor who played between the years of 1965-1980.





MKJ Group Family Stand: Our focal point for families visiting The Memorial Stadium, an independent stand offering the ideal location to start your journey as a young Rovers fan.

Cooling FX Terrace: Our family centric terrace offers close proximity to the tunnel, the atmosphere here feeds of the Thatcher's end, offering a lively but safe environment.





For the upcoming 23/24 Season, we have introduced new activities in our family zone, which is located behind the MKJ group family stand! Be sure to spend some time here enjoying everything we have on offer.

Food:

We will have a wide range of food on offer, including various healthy options.
